Financial Incentives

Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)

Employer may get up to a \$9,600 federal tax credit for a new hire that is a qualified veteran

On The Job Training (OJT)

Reimbursement of up to 50% of wages for up to six months

Apprenticeships

Veterans qualified for the Post 9/11 GI Bill can receive \$1104.75 per month for the first six months and \$810.15 per month for the second six months to supplement their wages while in an approved apprenticeship program
